- Clarify and provide documentation with respect to delineation of the VOC groundwater impacts adjacent to the LNAPL area in the southern part of the Site.
- Provide assistance to potential buyer in obtaining Prospective Purchaser Agreement with USEPA, if needed.
- Finalize Declaration of Restrictive Covenant.
