On behalf of Environmental Corporate Remediation (ENCORE), an environmental subsidiary of General Motors Corporation (GM), Conestoga-Rovers & Associates (CRA) has prepared this Addendum to the 2005 Investigation Work Plan (Addendum), which was submitted to the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ) on June 15, 2005 for the GM Metal Fabrication Division (MFD) Grand Rapids Metal Plant located at 300 36th Street S.W. in Wyoming, Michigan (Site). The purpose of this Addendum is to provide a schedule and more refined locations for the soil borings that will be advanced within the plant to further define the current soil conditions at the historic volatile organic compound (VOC) release area.

A total of nine soil borings, SB6-05 through SB14-05, will be advanced beginning on July 11, 2005. Soil borings and soil sample collection will be conducted as identified in the 2005 Investigation Work Plan. Proposed soil boring locations are presented on the attached Figure 3.2.
