SUBJECT: Request for DNR to Evaluate Land for Possible Contamination

On July 13, 1982, I met with Ted Gallinat, Supervisor, Charter Township of Flint, and Gordon Walter, Chief Building Inspector, Flint Township. These gentlemen were concerned about a 40 acre parcel of land presently owned by General Motors (see map for location). According to Mr. Walter this area was once used as a dumping ground for various "hazardous" wastes from nearby GM plants and DuPont. Most of the dumping took place in the 1930's. The dumping site was closed approximately 15 years ago.

Construction of a condominium project will begin sometime in the near future which will be located just west of this 40 acre site. Mr. Gallinat is concerned about the possibility of the groundwater being contaminated from this dump and would like DNR to evaluate it. No one from the township or Air Quality has made contact with GM regarding this site.
