Clarification of Statement in MDEQ Letter Dated July 16, 2004 Re:

Return to Compliance, Monitoring Well Location and Abandonment

Former Peregrine (US) Inc. Coldwater Road Facility Genesee Township, Michigan

The Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ), Waste and Hazardous Materials Division (WHMD), sent a letter dated July 16, 2004 to the Remediation and Hability Management Company Inc. (REALM) approving REALM's Monitoring Well Abandonment Report (Report) dated May 28, 2004. The July 16, 2004 letter stated " if at any later date either of the two remaining monitoring wells in question are located (MW-5 and MW-7)..." REALM would like to clarify that, as identified in Section 1.0 (third paragraph) and Figure 1 of the Report, and as shown on the boring logs for MW-5 and MW-7 presented in Attachment B of the Report, no monitoring wells were installed at these locations, because no water was identified during drilling. Their notation as wells on drawings was apparently a proposed work artifact from Peregrine documents and not representative of final conditions at the Site. All of the monitoring wells installed at the Facility have been either properly abandoned or are currently in use and in good condition.
