I got a call from a reporter from the Flint Journal yesterday asking questions about the Linden Road Landfill. I answered his questions as honestly as possible and he seemed satisfied. I don't think this will be anything big, but I thought I'd let you know, just in case. He said the story will run in a few days. I plan to call him back today and ask if he'll send me a copy of the story for the file.

FYI: Linden Road Landfill is a 40 acre parcel in Flint Township. It is owned by GM and they are in the final stages of RAP approval (legal agreements, covenants, etc) The contaminants include metals, VOCs and PNAs. Some groundwater contamination in an unusable upper aquifer. The proposed remedy is to cap the site, monitor the groundwater, and develop the site by constructing soccer fields. The category of RAP is Limited Recreational. After GM submits its administrative 'paperwork' (and its agreed to in principle) I will public notice the RAP and respond appropriately to any comments received. Meanwhile I am available to answer any questions that come up.
