

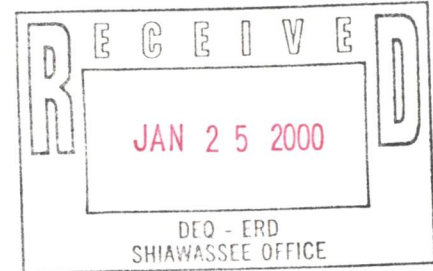

Dear Mr. Innes:

This letter is in response to your letter written to Mr. Robert Metcalf at General Motors (GM) dated 5 January 2000 presenting the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality's (MDEQ's) review comments on the above-referenced Baseline Groundwater Sampling Results. As requested in your letter and on behalf of GM, Roy F. Weston, Inc. (WESTON) has outlined herein a course of action to address the apparent low level exceedance of vinyl chloride concentration to the MDEQ Generic Drinking Water Criteria in Monitoring Well 11S.

WESTON/GM proposes to collect and analyze additional samples from Monitoring Well 11S to monitor the presence and concentration of vinyl chloride in this well. The Samples will be analyzed for volatile organic compounds. WESTON/GM plans to conduct this additional monitoring for three consecutive quarters beginning in mid February 2000. All sampling, sample handling, and laboratory methods will be consistent with those previously performed. The analytical results for each quarterly sampling event will be forwarded to MDEQ as soon as they are available.

Based upon the results of the additional sampling, WESTON/GM will propose a subsequent course of action as appropriate. A Notice of Migration of Contamination (Form EQP4482) will be submitted to MDEQ if the findings of the sampling proposed herein necessitate such action.
