Dear Mr. Hartnett:

As a follow up to our recent conversation regarding the General Motors (Central Foundry Division) Superfund (GM) site, please submit a schedule to address the remaining contamination at the site, as per the Records of Decision and Explanation of Significant Differences. As you know, these areas include the East Disposal Area, the North Disposal Area, the Industrial Landfill, the inactive lagoons and groundwater controls. The schedule should be submitted to EPA within 21 days of receipt of the letter.

In addition, in light of the recent announcement by GM that it will be closing the Massena, NY manufacturing facility, please submit a plan to identify and evaluate potential contamination in and beneath the existing plant buildings and structures, including any subsurface waste or wastewater conveyances. This plan must include the results of any previous surveys or data which have been collected and should be submitted within 30 days of the date of receipt of this letter.
