SUBJECT: Return to Compliance, Monitoring Well Location and Abandonment,
Former Peregrine (US), Inc., Coldwater Road Facility, Genesee Township,
Genesee County; MIR 000 020 743

The Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Waste and Hazardous Materials Division (WHMD), has reviewed the Remediation and Liability Management Company, Inc.'s (REALM) Monitoring Well Abandonment Report (Report), dated May 28, 2004. The Report was submitted in response to the WHMD's March 1, 2004, Notice of Violation Letter concerning the location and proper maintenance or abandonment of fourteen monitoring wells on the subject property. The Report is hereby approved and the facility has been returned to compliance regarding the issue.

Based on our review of the Report, it appears that the facility has made every possible effort to locate and/or decommission the fourteen monitoring wells in question, and has documented that 12 of the 14 monitoring well identified in WHMD's March 1 letter have been either properly abandoned or are currently in use and in good condition. In addition, the facility has documented that none of the wells in question were completed into the Drift Aquifer at the facility. However, if at any later date either of the two remaining monitoring wells in question are located (MW-5 and MW-7) or if any other unknown monitoring wells are located, the facility must properly abandon them in compliance with R 299.9629(6) of the Administrative Rules promulgated pursuant to Part 111, Hazardous Waste Management, of Michigan's Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended.
