Dear Mr. Horvath:

As previously communicated, General Motors Corporation filed for bankruptcy under Chapter 11 of the United States Bankruptcy Code on June 1, 2009. On July 10, 2009, General Motors Corporation, now known as Motors Liquidation Company (MLC), pursuant to a bankruptcy court order, sold certain assets, to a new entity, General Motors Company. General Motors Company subsequently changed its name to General Motors, LLC (GM LLC). The Site identified as the General Motors Grand Rapids Metal Plant location at 300 36<sup>th</sup> Street SW was not included in the sale and remains the property of MLC.

Currently, GM LLC conducts operations at the Site, under lease from MLC, and anticipates cessation of operations and vacating the Site on or before June 30, 2010. MLC hereby notifies the Michigan Department of Natural Resources and Environment (DNRE) Waste and Hazardous Materials Division (WHMD) Underground Storage Tank Program (USTP) of a name change for the UST registration from General Motors Corporation to Motors Liquidation Company.

Form EQP-3821 is enclosed as Attachment A. Additionally, Attachment B provides for delegation of signatory authority for documentation related to the registration.

It should be noted that on the DNRE's online Storage Tank Information Center, the tank location is listed as 35th Street. This is incorrect and is corrected on the attached EQP-3821.

**AUTHORIZATION TO PREPARE AND SIGN ENVIRONMENTAL PERMIT AND WASTE DISPOSAL DOCUMENTS ON BEHALF OF MOTORS LIQUIDATION COMPANY**

*Motors Liquidation Company (MLC)* hereby authorizes David Favero to sign discharge permit application and modification forms, agency notification letters, discharge monitoring reports, other reports required by environmental permits, waste manifests, and generator waste profiles on MLC's behalf, at MLC's request, for the properties and facilities owned by MLC.

This authorization is given based on the Authorized Individual's "first-hand knowledge" of the wastewaters, stormwater, emissions, and wastes generated by MLC. When executing discharge permit application and modification forms, agency notification letters, discharge monitoring reports, other reports required by environmental permits, waste manifests and generator waste profiles, the Authorized Individual shall sign as "*Agent for MLC*".

In connection with this authorization David Favero agrees to: (i) perform these responsibilities in accordance with all applicable laws and regulations governing storage, transportation and/or disposal of the materials; and (ii) maintain a copy of all such executed documents. MLC acknowledges and agrees that the Authorized Individual shall not incur, in connection with the execution of this authorization, any liability as a generator or a person arranging for the storage, transportation, treatment, or disposal of any product, material, substance or waste, the handling of which is regulated under any applicable federal, state, or local law, statute, act, ordinance, rule or regulation. Subject to any requirement to obtain bankruptcy court approval, MLC agrees to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless David Favero from and against any and all losses, liabilities, expenses, fines, penalties, damages, and other detriments of every nature and description (including but not limited to attorneys' fee) to which David Favero may be subjected as a result of claims, actions, proceedings (whether legal or administrative), or suits concerning the execution of manifests or generator waste profiles on behalf of MLC unless resulting from the gross negligence, willful misconduct or criminal acts of the Authorized Individual or failure of the Authorized Individual to comply with the requirements of this Paragraph.

The foregoing indemnity: (1) will not apply to any loss, claim, damage, or liability arising out of any contractual obligations to any third-party which David Favero may assume; (2) will not apply to any contamination caused or exacerbated by David Favero or any third party for which David Favero is legally liable; (3) will not apply to any damages or losses arising from the gross negligence, willful misconduct or criminal acts of David Favero; (4) will not apply to any damages or losses arising from loss of profits or business opportunity, or any other special or consequential damages incurred by David Favero; and (5) will, with regard to claims for remediation costs, apply only to such claims arising out of leaks, spills, or discharges which result in a level of contamination exceeding the current action levels established by the applicable governmental authorities and will be limited to such compliance responses as required by said governmental authority.

This authorization extends until December 31, 2010 and may be terminated at any time by MLC, provided such notice of termination shall be made in writing to David Favero. Obligations under this authorization shall survive termination or completion of services to MLC.
