General Motors Corporation filed for bankruptcy under Chapter 11 of the United States Bankruptcy Code on June 1, 2009. On July 10, 2009, General Motors Corporation, now known as Motors Liquidation Company (MLC), pursuant to a bankruptcy court order, sold certain assets, to a new entity, which is now known as General Motors, LLC (GM LLC). The Site identified as the Metal Fabricating Division (MFD) Grand Rapids Metal Plant was not included in the sale and ownership remains with MLC. No manufacturing operations will be conducted at the Site by MLC. Operations conducted by MLC at the Site will include required compliance monitoring, equipment sales, decommissioning, and demolition activities, as well as administrative and ancillary operational activities in support of the aforementioned activities.

Pursuant to the Michigan Medical Waste Regulatory Act, MLC is respectfully requesting termination of the Medical Waste Registration for Facility Registration No. 5110, Certificate No. 50420 for the MFD Grand Rapids Metal Plant.
