The Department may reject any petition filed more than 60 days after issuance as being untimely.

The issuance of this certificate of coverage does not authorize violation of any federal, state or local laws or regulations, nor does it obviate the necessity of obtaining such permits, including any other Department of Environmental Quality permits, or approvals from other units of government as may be required by law.

This certificate of coverage is based on a complete application received by the Department of Environmental Quality on September 21, 2007, and is subject to all conditions specified in General Permit No. MIS310000 issued September 19, 2007, expiring April 1, 2013.
