**RE: Report of Oil Release on to Building Slab – Report for Informational Purposes,  
NRC Report #902015, Former Peregrine Coldwater Road Property, 1245 E. Coldwater  
Road, Genesee Township, MI**

Dear Mr. Conforti:

This letter is written confirmation of the verbal report made to the National Response Center (NRC) and yourself on April 7, 2009, NRC Report Number 902015. This report is for informational purposes only as the oil is not believed to have reached the environment, but was cleaned up on the concrete.

This property is the former site of the Peregrine Manufacturing Facility, located at 1245 E. Coldwater Road in Genesee Township (Near Flint), Michigan. The manufacturing buildings on this property underwent demolition about 10 years ago and the property was investigated and interim cleanup was conducted under RCRA Corrective Action with the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ). The building floor slabs and roadways were left in place. Since that time, GM has leased the property to two different suppliers to GM. The area of concern in this letter is leased to Android to manage containers.

On April 6, 2009, GM was notified in the late afternoon that Android had noticed some bubbling in the pathway they used across the slab and that some blackish liquid with a sheen was coming up to the surface of the slab into water puddles on the concrete. It had rained and then snowed the night before and that morning and the plow had broken up some asphalt cover on the slab and pulled up an approximately 1" diameter pipe. The oil was either residual coming from the pipe or the area around the pipe between the asphalt and the concrete. GM's engineer and a cleanup contractor went to

the site to boom off the area and put absorbent pads on the area. These materials were later collected in a drum for future disposal. GM notified the NRC (Ms. Rawls) around 10:00 AM April 7, 2009 (Report #902015) as a precaution, for informational purposes only. Mr. Rich Conforti, the MDEQ's Corrective Action project manager for the former Peregrine Coldwater Road site, was also informed at that time.

On the morning of April 7, 2009, the engineer and cleanup contractor returned to the site. The pipe was cut off so that it did not stick up above the surface and grouted closed with a cement mix (no oil was noted in the pipe). All liquids in the area were vacuumed up and put in a poly tank for characterization and future disposal. Approximately 700 gallons of water were collected in a portable poly tank. This liquid is a mix of oil and melt water and rain water. (It is not known how much of the liquid is oil, but initial estimates by the engineer are less than 20 gallons, somewhere between 5 and 15 gallons. There is just a sheen at present in the tank.) Additional clean booms were laid out on the concrete in the area after cleanup to soak up any residual that might return after the slab was cleaned up. A visit was made on April 8, 2009 to check on conditions. No additional oily liquid was observed.

Additional visits will be made to the site to check on the cleanup and to do additional cleaning if needed. The liquid will be characterized and properly disposed, as well as the absorbent materials. Results are not yet back on analytical testing. The area that was affected is on the building slab and the oily water does not appear to have run off the slab. The storm drains on this property were previously properly abandoned as part of the demolition and there are no surface water bodies on the property.

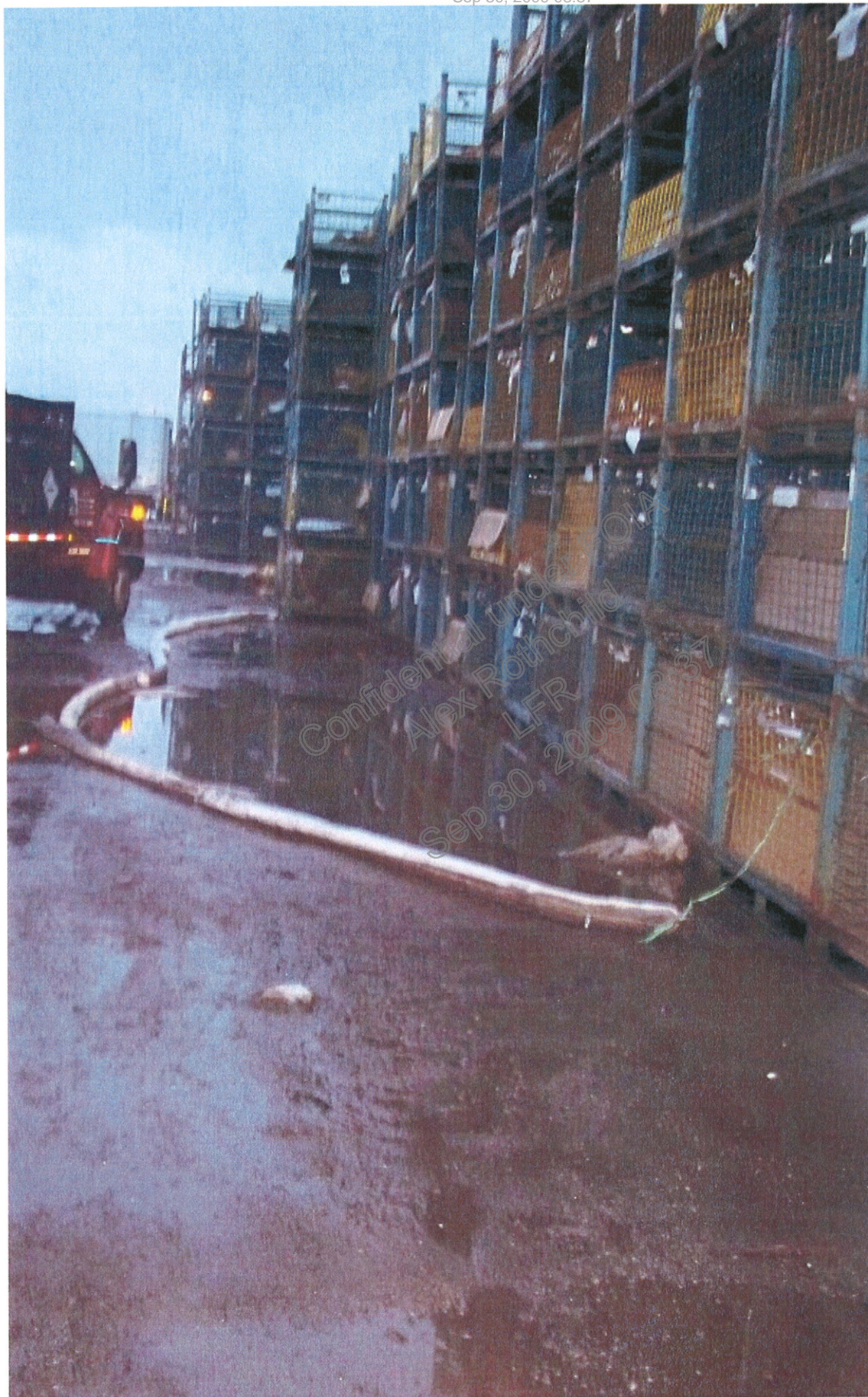

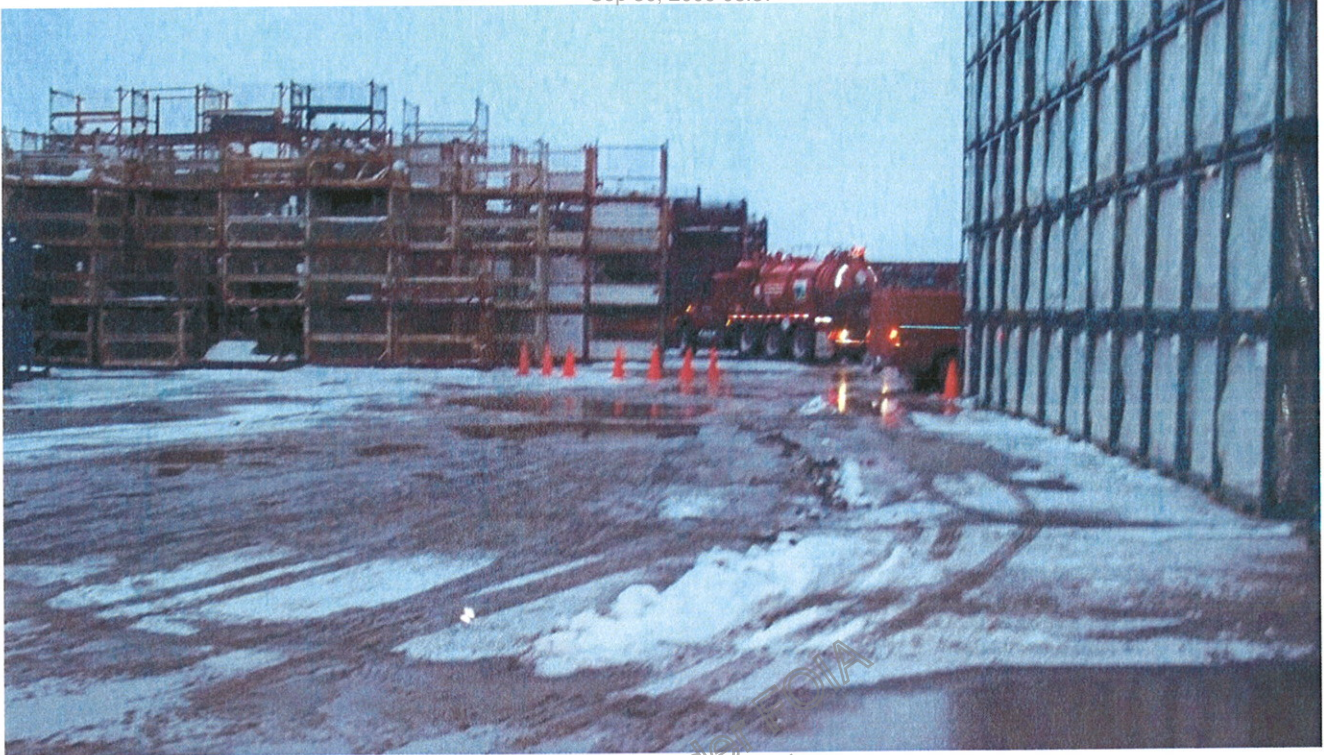
