**SUBJECT:** Fourth Annual Groundwater Sampling and Methane Monitoring  
Report Including Additional Investigations at the Linden Road  
Landfill, Genesee County

The Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) has received the subject report, dated January 21, 2004, and submitted on your behalf by Weston Solutions, Inc.

The extent of contamination in excess of generic residential cleanup criteria in the shallow groundwater near MW-3S appears to have been defined. The contamination, however, has migrated away from the facility boundary. As required in Section 2.4 of the Operation and Maintenance Plan, also identified as Attachment B of the Linden Road Landfill Remedial Action Plan, General Motors Corporation is hereby requested to propose a course of action concerning this matter. Please submit the requested proposal by March 1, 2004.
