Hi Jacob,

As you know we have scheduled the first round of soil gas sampling at Coldwater for next week. The future forecast looks like there might be a snow event Sunday and Monday followed by a warm up that might produce snow melt. The sampling should take one and a half days to two days to complete. Do you have an opinion on when the best time to sample might be? It looks like the best days are either Monday and Tuesday and deal with the snow and some snow melt or later in the week where the weather looks clear and hope the snow melt doesn't affect the sampling of the shallow locations.
