General Motors Corporation filed for bankruptcy under Chapter 11 of the United States Bankruptcy Code on June 1, 2009. On July 10, 2009, General Motors Corporation, now known as MLC, pursuant to a bankruptcy court order, sold certain assets, to a new entity, which is now known as General Motors, LLC (GM LLC). The Site identified as the Grand Rapids Metal Fabricating Plant was not included in the sale and ownership remains with MLC. GM LLC leased the site from MLC until June 30, 2010 at which time GM LLC ceased operations. No manufacturing operations are currently conducted at the Site by MLC. Operations conducted by MLC at the Site will include required compliance monitoring, equipment sales, decommissioning, and demolition activities, as well as administrative and ancillary operational activities in support of the aforementioned activities.
