NPDES Individual Permit TERMINATION



By letter received April 1, 2020, Mr. John-Eric Pardys representing Revitalizing Auto Communities Environmental Response (RACER) Trust stated that all surface water discharges from the RACER-Saginaw Nodular Industrial Land, 73-RACER-Saginaw Nodular Indust, have been eliminated and has requested that the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES). The NPDES Individual Permit No. MI0059042 be terminated. Contaminated sediment has been removed from the ponds and no further dewatering is needed.

Staff of the Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy, Water Resources Division has confirmed that all discharges previously directed to surface waters have been eliminated and has recommended that the NPDES Individual Permit be terminated.

Therefore, the NPDES Individual Permit No. MI0059042 is hereby terminated. There shall be no surface water discharge from this facility without applying for and obtaining a new NPDES permit.

This NPDES Individual Permit is terminated effective April 23, 2020.
