This will acknowledge receipt of your Certification of Completion of Post-Closure Care, dated May 1, 2018, June 29, 2018, August 27, 2018, October 11, 2018, December 13, 2018, June 26, 2019, August 26, 2019, and October 14, 2019 and received by the Illinois EPA May 1, 2018, July 2, 2018, August 28, 2018, October 12, 2018, December 14, 2018, June 27, 2019, August 27, 2019, and October 15, 2019, respectively.

Certification of Completion of Post-Closure Care

- 1. The Illinois EPA has determined that the post-closure care of the referenced site has been completed in accordance with the Post-Closure Care Plan and the certification, signed and sealed by Donald Sutton, P.E., signature dated April 26, 2018 and prepared by Thomas R. Beeching, both of GHD Services, Inc., and Robert W. Hare, P.E. of RACER Trust.
- 2. The date of completion of post-closure care is September 17, 2019.
- 3. Financial assurance is no longer required for the referenced site. If you wish to be released from any financial assurance that you are no longer required to maintain, you may file your written request with the Financial Assurance Unit at the address above. Include the site number for the facility with your request.
- 4. This correspondence constitutes final action by the Illinois EPA for the referenced site.

The applicant may appeal this final decision to the Illinois Pollution Control Board pursuant to Section 40 of the Act by filing a petition for a hearing within 35 days after the date of issuance of the final decision. However, the 35-day period may be extended for a period of time not to exceed 90 days by written notice from the applicant and the Illinois EPA within the initial 35-day appeal period. If the owner or operator wishes to receive a 90-day extension, a written request that includes a statement of the date the final
