On May 20, 2014, the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) inspected the landfill located at 1400 Lowell Street, Elyria, Ohio. Representing Ohio EPA were Rich Kurlich and me. The purpose of the inspection was to evaluate compliance with the Facility's Revised Post Closure Ground Water Monitoring Plan. In general, monitoring wells were in good condition and the facility was abiding by the Revised Post Closure Ground Water Monitoring Plan.
