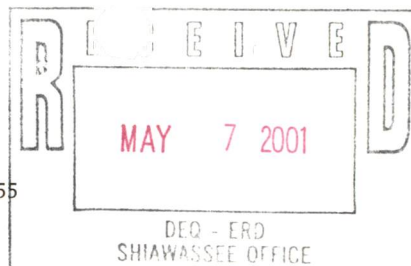

Re: Additional Methane Monitoring Results  
Linden Road Landfill Site

Dear Mr. Innes:

As proposed in Roy F. Weston, Inc. (Weston) letter to the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ) dated 9 January 2001, additional methane monitoring was completed at the Linden Road site. This additional monitoring was performed because of the elevated Lower Explosive Limit (LEL) registered in one of the Methane Monitoring Wells (M-1) during the monitoring conducted in October 2000. The following letter report presents the results of the most recent methane monitoring activity performed in April 2001.

The current methane-monitoring event was originally scheduled to be conducted during the last week of January 2001. However, due to prevailing weather conditions including a thick snow cover over the wells, the monitoring had to be postponed. On April 2, 2001, a Weston scientist screened the methane monitoring wells (M-1, M-2, M-3, M-4) shown in Figure 1 for methane gas. Monitoring was conducted using a combustible gas indicator (CGI), which measures the concentration of potential explosive gases based on the percentage of the LEL. Screening results indicated that well M-1 registered an LEL reading of 20 percent on the CGI. The remaining three wells registered 0 percent LEL.

Weston, on behalf of General Motors will continue to perform methane monitoring at the four wells (M-1, M-2, M-3, M-4) for two more quarters provided the LEL in all the four wells remain below 25 percent. However, methane monitoring will continue to be performed in conjunction with the annual groundwater monitoring as specified in the Operation and Monitoring Plan for the site. The results will be forwarded to the MDEQ pursuant to every monitoring event. The next methane monitoring activity will be conducted during the last week of June 2001. Weston will notify MDEQ of the actual monitoring date, a week in advance.

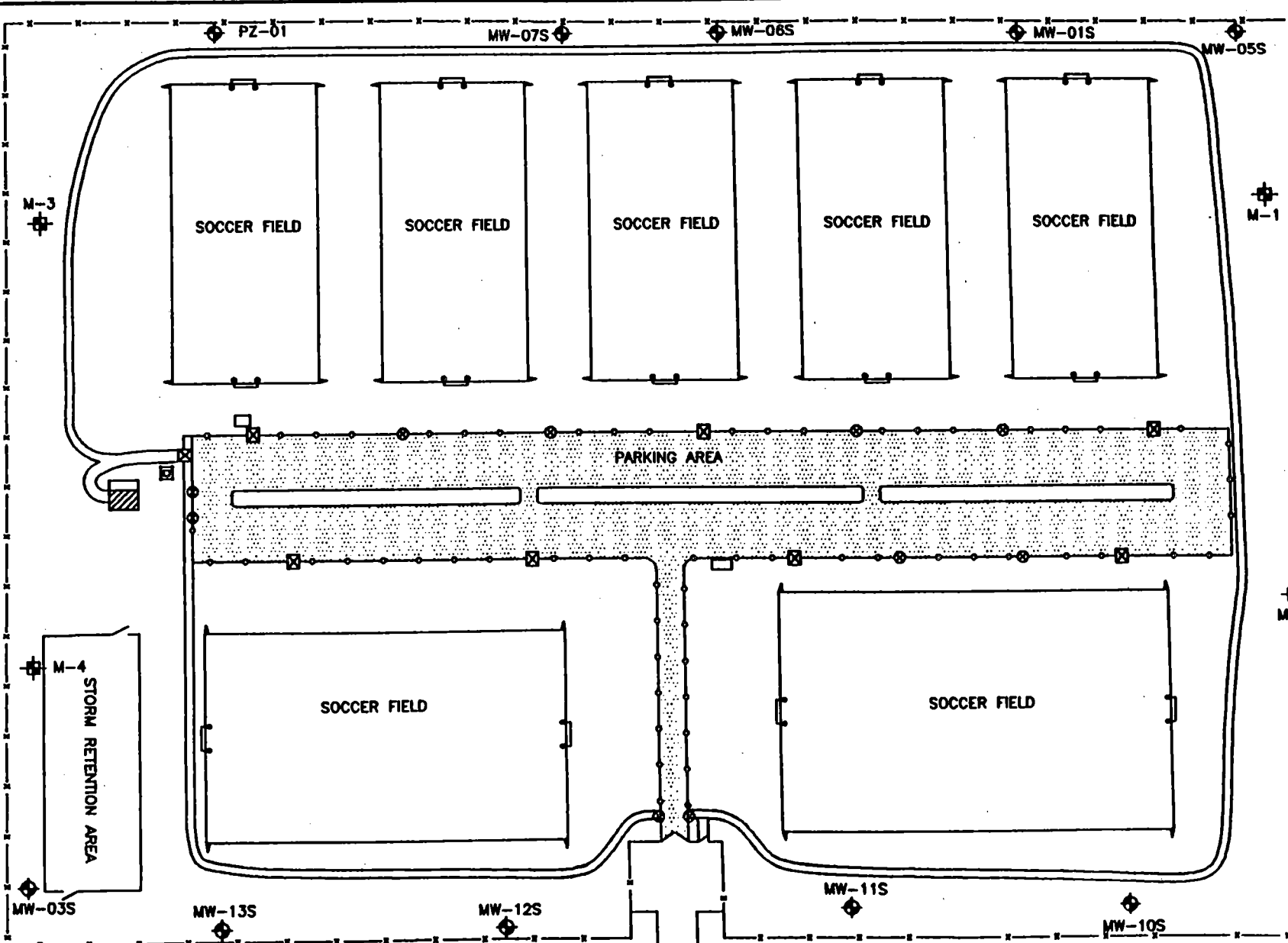

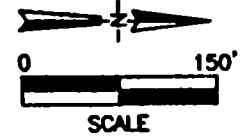
