SUBJECT: Linden Road Landfill

I attended a meeting on April 6, 1983 with Sibbald, Cummins and Kennedy to discuss a review of a consultant's survey prepared for this site. Sibbald had reviewed the work and sent a memo to Truchan on March 22, 1983 with recommendations addressing additional site study and preliminary cleanup.

As a result of the session, it was decided that the Lansing office staff of the Groundwater Quality Division would work further with their district compliance staff to collect additional samples, review historic (if not prehistoric) file information and determine if additional site work is necessary. It is my opinion that there is likely to be EED involvement in this matter at a later date, as it is evident that quite a substantial problem resulting from groundwater contamination exists.

Let me know if our branch is going to handle this matter (as opposed to Kennedy's branch). I'll be happy to take on GM Chevrolet.
