Michael,

You are correct in all aspects except the part about bi-annual. Bi-annual is every two years. The original agreement was that GM, or their designee, perform the inspections and provide documentation of the inspection to the State. I guess that means MLC or their designee. As the whole premise of the whole agreement is the presence of contamination on the property, I don't think MLC can designate this activity to the Soccer folks, unless they are CFR 1910.120 trained.

As for the monitoring wells, any wells used in monitoring the site, whether groundwater or soil gas, should be removed (if they haven't been already) and documentation of this action should be submitted to the State.

I hope this helps clear up your questions. If not give me a call. I plan to be in the office tomorrow but out on Monday for Presidents day.
